

## Anti-Worker Voting in the European Parliament by MEPs from far-right groups / far-right MEPs

*Examples of voting by MEPs from far-right groups / far-right MEPs in the European Parliament 2019-2024*

### Background

The 9<sup>th</sup> legislature of the European Parliament, whose last plenary took place in April 2024, has voted on numerous Regulations, Directives and Resolutions. Of these, we have selected some examples of pieces of legislation and reports that include positive measures for working people and trade unions. This is not an exhaustive list.

MEPs from far-right groups / far-right MEPs have repeatedly voted against key decisions for working people and trade unions.

These examples include – amongst others – measures to increase wages and to reinforce collective bargaining, to fight the gender pay gap, to reinforce social protection and ensure just transition, to protect workers rights and to improve the lives of workers.

You can find below these examples of pieces of legislation and reports together with the list of MEPs from far-right groups / far-right MEPs that voted against these pro-worker pieces of legislation / reports (by member state and political group). The analysis indicates the Group the MEPs belonged to at the moment of the vote. We have considered the final votes on the dossiers.

This analysis does not include the (numerous) MEPs from far-right groups / far-right MEPs who abstained on those votes.
